



## 2010 IIHF Youth Hockey Development Camp Information Sheet



### Camp Information

Hockey PEI has the opportunity to send one female defenseman to a Youth Hockey Development Camp in Vierumaki, Finland, July 3-11, 2010. A total of 3 Canadian players (1 goalie, 1 defenseman, and 1 forward) will represent Canada at the camp. Coaches, players and officials from 42 different nations across the world will take part.

The player selected will have one full week of elite on and off ice training. This is a once in a lifetime opportunity for an individual who wishes to broaden both their hockey knowledge and cultural background. A committee will be responsible for the selection of a player to attend the camp.

### Selection Criteria

- Female defenseman born in 1994
- Skilled on and off the ice with excellent social skills and attitude.
- Willing to maintain a diary and complete a post event report and speak (if requested) at Branch events.

### Player Costs

- 90% of travel (air from Canada to Helsinki, Finland return and ground travel in Canada) costs for the player to participate in the IIHF Youth Hockey Development Camp are covered by Hockey PEI.
- All on site costs such as meals, accommodations, ice, instruction, ground transportation and apparel are covered by the IIHF and Hockey Canada.
- 10% of the travel costs and any incidental costs (i.e. spending money) while on site are the full responsibility of the player.

**Deadline for applications is Friday April 30<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm.**

**\*\*\*\* The selected player must have a valid passport in order to travel to Finland.**
