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GENERAL INFORMATION

The first Atlantic Canada Sledge Hockey Development Camp is designed to provide a development opportunity to sledge hockey players in Atlantic Canada. Able-bodied hockey and sledge hockey coaches can also take part in on and off ice events. Participants should come out of this camp equipped with new on and off ice skills that they can take back to their clubs and teams and build upon throughout the 2010-11 season and beyond.

Hockey Canada, Hockey New Brunswick, Hockey Nova Scotia and Hockey PEI have partnered on this event and encourage all sledge hockey players in the region to attend.

This camp is designed for those with some existing sledge hockey background, but a high skill level is not required, just basic sled, stick and puck skills. Those new to sledge hockey who want to try the sport are welcome to do so in Halifax on Friday July 30 from 2-4PM at the Civic Arena. Details will be circulated in advance of that open session.

Wolfville, Nova Scotia on campus at Acadia University.

COSTS

TOTAL CAMP COST PER PARTICIPANT: \$250

Included in costs:

- 3 nights' accommodation at Acadia dorms
- Meals from Tuesday evening to Friday morning on campus at Acadia
- All ice times (4 hours per day) on campus at Acadia
- Off-ice activities
- Camp t-shirt
- Sledge hockey resources

Participants are also responsible for their own transportation to and from camp. Once on site in Wolfville we will walk and/or carpool as necessary.

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CAMP SCHEDULE

Detailed camp schedule will be provided closer to the date of camp but participants should aim to arrive in Wolfville by 7:00PM on July 27 and can depart anytime in the morning of July 30.

EQUIPMENT/WHAT TO BRING

Participants are responsible to bring their own sled, sticks, and full hockey gear in order to participate. This includes helmet with face shield, neck guard, shoulder pads, elbow pads, gloves, pants and shin pads (if applicable). If you typically borrow equipment from your local club or league please make arrangements to borrow equipment for this camp.

You should bring workout gear (t-shirt, shorts, running shoes, etc.) for off-ice activities. Participants will need to bring clothing and personal items for a 3 night event. Dress code will be casual - make sure you are ready for warmer and cooler weather.

NATIONAL TEAM ATTENDANCE

3 athletes and a coach from the national sledge hockey team pool will be attending this camp and will be on and off ice to provide instruction and guidance for all camp participants. These individuals are outstanding resources for all participants and are there to help, answer questions, and provide assistance wherever possible.
