Tournament Rules

Divisions	Under 30	– Maximum 8 teams
	30 & Over	– Maximum 16 teams

- Two referees per game.
- Each game to consist of a 5 minute warm-up with 55 minutes straight time period.
- Penalties for slap shots (stick raised above the knee).
- Body checking is not permitted.
- Throwing of stick will result in a penalty.
- Penalties of 3 minutes will start at the drop of the puck for straight time being served.
- Fighting or Abuse of Officials will result in suspension from further tournament play. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Each game will have a winner. If at the end of regulation time, the score is still tied a shootout will occur. Three (3) players from each side. If score is still tied, One (1) different player will continue shootout until all players are used before a player shoots a second time.

OTHER

- Tournament is open to non-registered and Hockey Canada registered teams. Non-registered teams are permitted to register with Hockey Canada and obtain the insurance policy. Teams interested in the Hockey Canada insurance benefits can contact Hockey PEI for additional details.
- Registered players in the 2009-2010 season with any junior, senior or university teams are **not eligible** to participate with any team. Tournament organizers will determine eligibility of players.
- The Under 30 division requires a minimum of 4 teams.
- Entry Deadline – March 1, 2010
