**Julie Healy**

**Hockey Canada – Director, Female Hockey**

Julie has been director of female hockey with Hockey Canada since August 2002. She is responsible for overseeing all aspects of female development and high performance programming, including the National Women's Team, the National Women's Under-22 Team and the National Women's Under-18 Team. Her experience with Team Canada at International events in the past is very extensive ranging from international exhibition tournaments, 4 Nations Cup, World Championships and the Olympics.

Julie's coaching experience is also very impressive including Esso Women's National Championships, winning gold twice and spent 14 seasons as an assistant coach with the University of Concordia capturing two national Championships in 1998 and 1999.

She maintains her coach certification with Level 4 as per the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP). Julie is a graduate of Concordia University, where she received a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science.
