



Policy Regarding Participation in National or Regional Championships

As a member branch of Hockey Canada, Hockey PEI participates annually in a number of national and regional championship events.

In the event that a team wins a Hockey PEI provincial championship which leads to a national or regional championship, that team is required to participate in that championship to retain its status and privileges as a member in good standing of Hockey PEI.

Any team or association that withdraws from a national or regional championship or fails to participate as required in such championship, may be subject to a fine and/or suspension by the Hockey PEI Board of Directors.

If a provincial championship team is unable to commit to its respective national or regional championship, Hockey PEI reserves the right to select an alternate representative from one of the other teams in that league. In such a case, fines and/or suspensions to the withdrawing team may still be applicable.
